<p>CORRUGATED CARDBOARD</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • NO Waxed Cardboard • NO plastic strings • NO misc food boxes • NO gift boxes • Boxes must be flattened • All brown corrugated cardboard boxes • NO shinny or veggie waxed box <p>ALUMINUM</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Large pieces • Beverage cans • Foil and pans keep separate from cans <p>SCRAP METAL</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Steel, iron, tin cans, car parts, tire rims, stoves, and hot water heaters are acceptable. • Any LARGE pieces of aluminum • Is it tin or Aluminum? To find out if a can is aluminum test it with a magnet. If it is aluminum, the magnet will NOT stick. <p>TEXTILE</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clothing & shoes some linens 	<p>PAPER</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Single/mix Sheets Office Paper, white or pastel • Newspaper, catalogs, memos, file folders, glossy paper, phone books, carbonless forms, colored paper, junk mail, magazines, post-it-notes, white paper, white/color ledgers, white/brown chip board, hard back books w/covers removed, envelope. No food or beverage contamination <p>USED OIL</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Antifreeze CANNOT be mixed with used oil • NO WATER, DIRT, or CHEMICAL CONTAMINANTS <p>ELECTRONICS(call for additional)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Desk/labtops • LCD, LED, Plasma TV's • Flat screen monitors • Server/ router/switches • Cell phones, cameras 	<p>PLASTIC #1 & #2</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Water/soda bottles • Liquid soap bottles • Some household cleaning bottles • Liquid bleach bottles • Milk jugs • Liquid fabric softener bottles • Liquid washing detergent bottles • NO plastic bags • NO 5 gal buckets, yogurt containers or flower pots <p>#1 or #2 symbols under bottom</p> <p>BATTERIES</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Car batteries • Lawn mowers <p>WHITE GOODS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Refrigerators, freezers, washers, dryers, dishwashers, etc. <p>NO GLASS RECYCLING NO TIRE RECYCLING (leave where purchased)</p>	<p>REUSED IT!</p> <p>Recycling is the final step before an item goes in a landfill. As you do your recycling, think about how it could be reused.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Reused by donating items ➤ Reused by selling it at a garage sale or consignment shop. <p>Brunswick County has many thrift stores, antique shops, and junkyards that take reusable items.
