

MEETING WITH COUNTY LEADERS ON MARCH 20-23, 2020

COVID-19 (CORONAVIRUS) PREPAREDNESS

BRUNSWICK COUNTY GOVERNMENT

- Dr. Harris, Board of Supervisor Chair, and Dr. Woolridge participated in a White House COVID-19 Briefing Call on March 18, 2020.
- The Southside Health District announced on March 20, 2020, its first COVID-19 case in the district. The resident of Mecklenburg is a male in his 50's who had contact with a person in another part of Virginia who was diagnosed with COVID-19.
- On March 20, 2020, Brunswick County issued a notice to close offices to the public effective immediately.
- Brunswick County has modified its staffing to essential personnel only.
- On March 20, 2020, the Board of Supervisors sent a letter to citizens, business and religious leaders to provide an update of COVID-19.
- A Declaration of Location Emergency was adopted by the Board of Supervisors on March 20, 2020.
- On Friday, March 20, staff (County Administrator, Assistant County Administrator, and Emergency Services Coordinator) called the three funeral home directors (Brown's Funeral Home, Pearson's Funeral Home and Williams Funeral Home) in our County to discuss safety and COVID-19 information.
- Continue to facilitate ongoing discussions with regional County Administrators.

ENVOY OF LAWRENCEVILLE

- Dispatch is screening emergency calls to determine if patient has symptoms associated with COVID-19.

- Following Old Dominion Emergency Medical Services Alliance (ODEMSA) protocols and Center for Disease Control (CDC) guidelines when answering suspected COVID-19 calls.
- Working to obtain masks which are in limited supply nationwide.
- ODEMSA provided 40 masks to each EMS agency.

SCHOOLS (BRUNSWICK COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS)

- On March 23, 2020, Governor Northam announced the closure of all public and private schools through the end of the 2019-20 academic year.
- The Virginia Department of Education will provide all school divisions in the Commonwealth with guidance for providing food service and the continuity of instruction in an equitable manner while schools are closed.
- Dr. Lane, State Superintendent, and his office will provide guidance regarding the following:
 - Graduation for Seniors
 - How to issue standard and verified credits with a focus on differentiated requirements for a 12th grader
 - Allow for new instruction
 - Ensuring equity for students with disabilities

- We had a reduced workforce at the Agency today. We will begin the week of March 23rd providing services/benefits to Brunswick County citizens with a reduced workforce at the Agency and some staff tele-working. Some logistics still needs to be worked out before this can be fully implemented, but I anticipate this to be implemented on March 24th.
- Requests to use up to \$5,000 of the Agency's FY-20 local budget allocation to provide services, stability and safety to seniors and families who need crisis intervention with shelter, food, and utilities during this health crisis. We currently have less than \$100 in the Agency's Special Welfare Emergency fund.
